DECLARATION FOR WINTER SNOW
AND ICE STORM

RESOLUTION &
ORDER NO. 2024-025
(Declaring State of Emergency)

WHEREAS, ORS 401.305 through 401.335 provides authority for Linn County to act as an emergency management agency, including authority to establish policies and procedures for defining and directing responsibilities during time of emergency, and to declare the existence of a state of emergency in Linn County;

WHEREAS, Linn County has enacted Linn County Code Chapter 235, pursuant to authority granted by ORS Chapter 203 and Chapter 401, that provides for executive responsibilities in times of emergency and specifically delegates authority to declare a state of emergency to the Linn County Board of Commissioners (Board). If circumstances prohibit the timely action of the Board, a state of emergency may be declared and duties performed by the following in the following order, the Chair of the Board, Vice-Chair of the Board, third member of the Board, County Administrative Officer, and Emergency Program Manager, provided that the approval of a majority of the Board is sought and obtained at the first available opportunity;

WHEREAS, The following conditions have resulted in the need for a declaration of a state of emergency: Winter snow and ice storms in many areas of Linn County beginning approximately January 13, 2024 and ongoing as of this Declaration;

WHEREAS, The following damage to life and property can be expected from the above conditions: Widespread power, roadway, and communications infrastructure damage resulting in the



1 loss of power to at least 6,000 residents, some in excess of 100 hours, and loss of cell phone tower
2 communications causing 911 services outage for portions of the County, which along with roadway
3 infrastructure damage is causing delays or inability to respond of first responder and ambulance
4 services; and

5 WHEREAS, the entire County is in a state of emergency; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED and ORDERED, That the Vice-Chair of the Board, William C. Tucker, in the
7 absence of the Chair of the Board, formally declares a state of emergency for Linn County, effective
8 on this _____ day of January, 2024 at _____ a.m./p.m. for the area described above;

9 ORDERED, That upon this declaration of a state of emergency the undersigned official is
10 empowered to assume control of and have authority over all departments and offices of the County in
11 accordance with the provisions of LCC Chapter 235, and further that the County Office of
12 Emergency Management is empowered to carry out the appropriate function and duties identified in
13 LCC Chapter 235 during times of emergency and shall implement the Linn County Emergency
14 Operations Plan;

15 ORDERED, That the Emergency Management Director shall take all necessary steps
16 authorized by law to coordinate response and recovery from this emergency, including, but not
17 limited to, requesting assistance from the State of Oregon;

18 ORDERED, That this declaration of a state of emergency shall be taken before the Linn
19 County Board of Commissioners at the first available opportunity for ratification; and



The attached tables include the Department's current FY2023-24 Revenue Summary and Permit Activity Reports through December 31, 2023. Also attached with this memorandum is the list of December 2023 land use applications received, a code enforcement summary, and current wildfire permitting reports. The December 2023 Department update is summarized below.

PLANNING

- Land use permits issued in December 2023 totaled 30.
- There is no Planning Commission meeting scheduled for January 2024.
- There is no Board hearing scheduled for January 2024.

BUILDING

- Total County building permits issued in December 2023, including non-structural permits, totaled 196. The number of building permits issued for dwellings in December totaled 20: 3 single family dwellings and 6 manufactured dwellings. 9 permits were issued for dwelling additions/alterations and 2 permits for accessory buildings were issued. Total number of Commercial permits issued totaled 2. Out of the 196 combined residential and commercial permits, 36 required plan review.
- Total contract city permits issued in December 2023, including non-structural permits, totaled 17; There were 0 contract city permits issued in December for new single-family dwellings, 0 permits for a manufactured dwelling and 3 permits were issued for dwelling additions/alterations and 0 permits for accessory buildings were issued. Total number of Commercial permits issued totaled 5. Out of the 17 combined residential and commercial permits, 1 required plan review.

CODE ENFORCEMENT

- Total new cases for December 2023 was 13.
- Total cases closed in December 2023 was 21.

WILDFIRE GRANT

- We have had no new fire hardening applications and have not issued any grant checks.

Highlighted Cases 12/14/2023

Code Enforcement and the Building Official met with the owner of the former Gates School property in Gates who now operates an Upward Bound Camp for special needs kids at that location. There had been concern about the use of the building for overnight stays after it had been damaged in the Beachie Creek fire. The owner gave a tour of the building that clearly showed it was only used for daytime activities. There are two manufactured homes on the property that provide overnight use for the owner and staff. Other than some minor expired electrical work and a manufactured home placement, all else was found to be in compliance.

12/14/2023

A property owner on Gates Bridge East in Gates had converted part of a shop building into a dwelling without permits or land use approval. Because of the Exclusive Farem Use zoning, a soils test was required to determine the farm value of the land before he could apply for the permits to legally convert part of the shop into a dwelling. He had been notified to obtain the soils report months ago and was then cited after failing to act. Note: the original complaint was received in September 2022 and numerous personal visits and phone calls failed to encourage him to obtain the soils report.

Special Meetings

12/04/2023

Code Enforcement attended an event at the main Albany Fire Station called "Improve your Community Connections" and met with representatives from several agencies who provide services as needed to the Linn County community. A large portion of agency assistance involves dealing with housing and drug/alcohol issues which are often factors in complaints received by Code Enforcement. This event is held on the first Monday of each month, beginning at 11:45AM, at the fire station.

Court Cases

12/20/2023

Two cases appeared in front of Judge Meyer that addressed multiple people living in RVs, tents and outbuildings. The first case was a follow up to a hearing in November where the property owner on River Drive in Lebanon had agreed to follow an agreement to do specific things each month to avoid being fined. The owner met the agreement for the December hearing and his case will be carried over to January 2024. He will need to file for legal evictions of the remaining campers on his property before the January hearing.

12/20/2023

The second case was the first appearance for the property owner and eight campers from a 15-acre property on Wiley Creek in Sweet Home who were cited for occupying RVs, tents and outbuildings. The owner pleaded "No Contest" and had signed an agreement to do specific actions before the January court date. He has handed out his own eviction notices to each camper and will then need to file for legal eviction in court for anyone who does not move off his property. One person cited pled "Not Guilty" stating she did not live on the property and was only there to help a friend. Judge Meyer set a status hearing in January to determine if her case needs to go forward to a trial.
