MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

RE: Paid Leave Oregon (PLO) AND Associated Leave year adjustments

This MOU is entered into by and between Linn County ("County") and the Linn County Juvenile Detention Association ("Association").

Recitals:

- On September 3, 2023 employees, through Oregon law, became eligible to take leave time, for what has become known as Paid Leave Oregon (PLO).
- As part of the statutory scheme, the parties are entering into this LOA to clarify certain matters surrounding the PLO legislation.

Agreement:

Therefore, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The parties agree to the County's proposed changes to Linn County Personnel Policy Manual, section 20:390 "Leaves authorized by Federal or State laws." (attached).
 - a. Under the proposed changes, the County will allow supplementation of leave time taken for PLO, for OFLA/FMLA qualifying leaves.
 - b. Those supplementations will be allowed retroactive to September 3, 2023.
- 2. As per the PLO legislation, PLO leaves will have a "rolling forward" leave year.
- 3. The parties agree that, as of January 1, 2024, any OFLA or FMLA qualifying leaves will also be calculated on a "rolling forward" leave year. Therefore, Article 18, section 8 will be modified, effective January 1. 2024 to move to a "rolling forward" leave year.
- 4. The parties will maintain the status quo as to applicability of leave donation provisions, as well as benefit accruals while out on paid leave status.
