
Linn County 6th Graders Report Improvement in Prevention Knowledge and Skills

During the 2019-2020 school year, Linn County Alcohol and Drug Prevention Program provided Life Skills Training to 820 sixth grade students Linn attending County Schools. Sixth graders who completed the Life Training survey report having more of the skills they need to refuse alcohol and other drugs. Post-survey results

indicate that 85% of Linn County sixth graders report increased knowledge of decision-making skills, 85% of an increase report knowledge in refusal skills and 79% report an increase in knowledge related to harmful effects of alcohol use. Furthermore. 84% report increased knowledge of the harmful effects of problem
